

## HOW TO INSTALL THE ADD-IN GRAPH2009.XLA

- 1) Save to file *graph2009.xla* to your computer

You can copy it anywhere but there is a better choice than others: If you can find the “macrolib” folder or “add-ins” folder of microsoft office, copy the file into this folder. I do not give the exact path of this folder because it changes depending on the version of Microsoft office. However, there is a way to know the location of this file.

In Excel, go to the tools menu and select “Add-ins”. Click on Browse. In the top of the window, immediately under the title bar, you should have “look in: macrolib” or “look in: Add-Ins”. If you click on the arrow pointing down just to the right, you can see the full folder path. Don’t worry if it doesn't work, you can copy the file anywhere.

- 2) Check « graphique de science » in the Add-Ins

On the Excel menu, go to the tools menu and select “Add-Ins...”. If you have placed the file in the macrolib folder or the Add-Ins folder, “graphique de science” will appear in the list and you only have to check the box. Then click on OK.

If you have placed the file elsewhere on your computer, you must click on browse and indicate where the file is. Once this is done, you have to check science graph and click OK.

It is now ready. To make it work:

Enter your data on an Excel sheet  
Click on the “graphique de science” icon
